Time: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

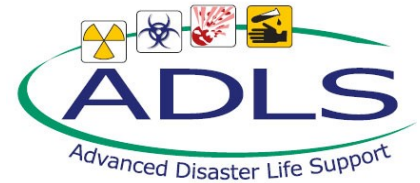
