Information on EMS/Hospice Partnership

1. Uncoordinated care for the patient
 - a) Patient receives unwanted treatment
 - b) Confusion over patient wishes
2. Coordinated Care for the patient
 - a) Patient receives care in line with hospice plan of care
 - b) Patient's goals are met
 - c) Improved EMS/Hospice relationship
3. Partnership leads to comprehensive program
 - a) Home management of the Patient
 - b) Cost reduction for EMS and Hospice
 - c) Family counseled to relieve anxiety
 - d) EMS and Nurses work hand in hand to meet patient needs
4. Benefits for EMS, Hospice and Patient
 - a) Decreases hospitalization/rehospitalizations
 - b) Relieves confusion for EMS for care of patient and their goals
 - c) Relieves confusion with ER staff for the Hospice patient
 - d) Patient's preferred treatment for end of life is respected
