- Class will run from January 24<sup>th</sup> – June 1<sup>st</sup> 2019
- Must be at least 16 years old by start of class
- Classes held on Monday and Thursday nights from 6:00-9:30 with possible Saturdays
- Classes will be held at the beautiful NCI campus @ 191 Fayette Street Martinsville, VA
- Students who successfully complete all course requirements will be eligible to take the National Registry EMT Certification Examination
- National Registry EMT Certification allows the students to be eligible for Advanced Placement in the PHCC EMS-Paramedic Program (EMT = 8 credits)
- VA OEMS applications for scholarships will be available to apply for to cover course fee of \$500
- Class size limited to 30 students - so register early!

1. Have the knowledge and skills needed to handle emergencies
2. Volunteer at local fire & rescue agencies and help our communities
3. Gain employment in many areas such as, but not limited to: public safety agencies, municipal fire departments, sheriff's departments, 911 centers, private or hospital-based ambulance services and more!
