



# ADULT Gold/Trauma Alert Criteria

Patients with a Confirmed or Suspected Traumatic Mechanism of Injury

<b>Gold Alert</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Traumatic Arrest/CPR</li><li>* Airway/respiratory compromise or any intubated patient</li><li>* GCS <math>\leq</math> 8</li><li>* SBP &lt; 100</li><li>* Penetrating injury: head, neck, back, chest, abdomen, pelvis, or extremities proximal to elbow/knee</li><li>* Amputation, crushed, mangled, de-gloved or pulseless extremity proximal to wrist/ankle</li><li>* Uncontrolled hemorrhage, vascular injury, or tourniquet in place</li><li>* Blood product administration for perfusion</li></ul>	
<b>Trauma Alert</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* HR &gt;120 only if age is <math>\geq</math>65 (Geriatric Population)</li><li>* GCS 9-13</li><li>* Paralysis</li><li>* Burn &gt; 20% TBSA</li><li>* Confirmed TBI (SDH, EDH, SAH) on anticoagulation/antiplatelet therapy</li></ul>	
<b>Trauma Consult</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Pregnancy &gt;20 weeks (may meet OB alert criteria)</li><li>* Need for Trauma Clinic follow-up (Mon/Thurs)</li><li>* TBI with any loss of consciousness and GCS is 14-15</li></ul>
