



EMT Certification Class—Chatham, Virginia

The Emergency Medical Technician course is designed to provide training to prepare an individual to function independently in a medical emergency. This course provides the basic knowledge and skills needed to provide basic life support (BLS) care and is required to progress to more advanced levels of pre-hospital patient care.

START DATE: JUNE 9, 2014

END DATE: OCT. 29, 2014

TEST DATE: NOV 1, 2014

The course will be composed of the following:

- 105 hours minimum of Didactic instruction
- 45 hours minimum of Skills/Lab sessions
- 16 hours approximately of Online courses
- 10 hours minimum Truck/Field time (must have 10 patient contacts)

8:00 am - 3:00 pm

Course Cost is \$410.00* and includes: (must be paid by first class)

- Initial Psychomotor (practical) testing fee
- Initial Cognitive (written) testing fee (paid by the State)
