Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS)

A PALS course has been scheduled for November 1-2, 2014 from 8:30a-5p at the Public Safety Training Center. Fees for the course are: Virginia EMS providers* (\$75) and Non-EMS provider, MD, PA, RN, etc. (\$155.00). Registration and course fee must be received by October 17, 2014

Course Description:

The completely redesigned American Heart Association Pediatric Advanced Life Support course is based on new science evidence from the *2010 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC* and a new teaching methodology. The goal of the PALS course is to aid the pediatric healthcare provider in developing the knowledge and skills necessary to efficiently and effectively manage critically ill infants and children, resulting in improved outcomes. Skills taught include recognition and treatment of infants and children at risk for cardio-pulmonary arrest; the systematic approach to pediatric assessment; effective respiratory management; defibrillation and synchronized cardioversion; intraosseous access and fluid bolus administration; and effective resuscitation team dynamics.
